Our charges will be calculated mainly by reference to the time actually spent by the solicitor and other staff in respect of any work which they do on your behalf. If the other party disputes your claim at any point, we will discuss with you any further work required and provide you with revised advice about costs which could be on a fixed fee (e.g. if a one-off letter is required), or an hourly rate if more extensive work is needed.

The costs indicated above are not for matters where enforcement action such as the bailiff is needed to collect your debt.

- Undertaking appropriate searches;
- Sending letter before action;
- Receiving payment and sending on to you or if the debt is not paid drafting and issuing a claim;
- Where no Acknowledgement of Service or Defence is received, applying to the Court to enter Judgement in default;
- When Judgement in default is received, writing to the other side to request payment;
- If payment is not received within a reasonable time providing you with advice on the next steps and likely costs.

Matters usually take between 8 and 26 weeks from receipt of instructions from you to receipt of payment from the other side depending on whether or not it is necessary to issue a claim. This is on the basis that the other side pays promptly on receipt of Judgement in default. If enforcement action is necessary the matter will take longer to resolve and involve additional costs.
